

FROM THE VICAR'S DESK

BE STILL AND KNOW THAT I AM GOD (PSALM 46: 1 - 11)

Dear all, Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

We are entering the last quarter months of 2023. We thank God for making it this far. Detailed information about various programs of the parish for the next three months is published in this newsletter. I look forward to everyone's prayerful presence and cooperation.

Here I am sharing a short meditation:

Psalm 46, written by the sons of Korah, the chief musicians in the Jerusalem temple, says that God is the refuge and the strength of the people. The Psalm concludes with the lines, 'Be still and know that I am God.' What does it mean?

Firstly, allow God to work: The Gospel according to Mark 4: 35 - 41 portrays an extremely busy day for Jesus, a day when He was healing people, casting out demons, and speaking, after which, He may have been exhausted and overwhelmed. He requested a boat for a bit of respite and quiet. On the journey, a huge storm rolled in. The disciples became afraid of their lives. They looked to Jesus for help and found him fast asleep from exhaustion. They were terrified because of the storm and woke him up. Jesus got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Peace, Be Still!" The storm and the huge waves stopped immediately.

Secondly, allow God to speak: How often do we ask God for everything, but we don't stop to listen or to be still? Moreover, our attitude changes. We think that when we speak, others should hear. So, people use high-syllable loudspeakers and horns. The act of being still and getting quiet becomes more of a challenge in our hectic world. The world asks us to be busy. God asks us to be still so that we can receive love, peace, and guidance.

Thirdly, allow God to be the Center: We must learn to quiet our fearful and anxious thoughts, just as Jesus calmed the sea. Jesus immediately asked the question to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Have you so little faith?" In these days, quieting the mind requires lot of effort. When we have fearful and anxious thoughts that are raging within us like a violent storm, do as Jesus did. We need to silence those thoughts by allowing God to be the center of our boat so that we know who God in our lives is.

Our life is becoming more mechanical, because of our busy schedules. But God is knocking at the doors of our lives. If we allow Him to come in, we can

have fellowship with Him. Moreover, he who abides in Him will bear more fruit.

TRUSTEES' CORNER

We're pleased to announce the successful completion of several projects:

- 1. Main Parking Lot The repair of the driveway extending all the way back to the auditorium building. The blacktop coating of the parsonage driveway is also completed.
- 2. Parsonage Basement Pantry.
- 3. Sanctuary Electrical Wires Thanks to the dedicated efforts of Mr. Philip K. Mathew and team, we've removed/fixed all loose electrical wires in Sanctuary.
- 4. Altar Replacement of ceiling lights, painting, replacing the exhaust fan in the bathroom, and the building of an access to the attic for audiovisual purposes. This access point is strategically placed right outside the choir exit door.
- 5. Altar Paraments We extend our heartfelt thanks and appreciation to Ron Jacob and Sarah Jacob for their generous contributions towards the Altar Paraments, including a new Kappa. Ron personally brought the entire consignment to the US from his recent trip to India for the Mandalam Meeting.
- 6. Auditorium Tables In time for the Harvest Festival, we successfully replaced all the old tables in the auditorium.
- 7. Gates and Railings Our gates and railing project has been completed as planned. Additionally, we are pleased to share that the Daycare has taken the initiative to install additional railing work around the play area, costing \$3,945, which they have agreed to cover as per our meeting and agreement.
- 8. HVAC Unit The HVAC unit by the Daycare has been successfully replaced. In addition to this, we are in the process of implementing a preventive maintenance contract for the other HVAC units. The Daycare is willing to split the cost of the preventive maintenance contract for the HVAC units.
- 9. New Sign Board New signboards have been installed for both the Church and the Rectory.

Projects that are in progress.

- 1. Main Parking Lot We are in the process of obtaining the necessary permit from Nassau County for the apron and walkways. Once we receive the permit, we will promptly schedule the work.
- 2. Parsonage We will be installing additional cabinets and granite countertops on the 1st floor of the Parsonage.
- 3. Auditorium Stage and Electrical Work The work has not been scheduled yet, as this work can only be done on weekends.
- 4. Power washing of the brick wall surrounding the church building, painting of the iron grills located between the brick walls, and application of silicon coating on the brick wall.
- 5. Auditorium Entry and Patio We are planning to do repair and maintenance work for the Auditorium Entry and Patio, with main focus on the brickwork. Additionally, we will be making modifications to a portion of the steps to provide wheelchair access.

Finance

We will be sending out the year-to-date statement of personal contributions to all the members during the 1st week of October 2023. Those who have not contributed their shares, especially the past dues, please do so at your earliest convenience.

A financial sheet is prepared with the minimum expected contributions from the members of the church is also published in the following page. For your information, this is only a guideline, and if you have any questions, please see the Trustees.

We will need approximately \$50,000 in the next couple of weeks to make payments towards HVAC, concrete work, sign boards, and other maintenance works, plus 3rd quarter contra payments to the Diocese.

Daycare

In addition to the regular lease payments, the Daycare has already contributed \$18,750.00 towards HVAC, and will further contribute \$10,000 towards maintenance work during the last quarter of this year.

In a recent meeting with Daycare, Director Chiara Ottomano thanked and appreciated the church officials and members of the church for the upkeeping and maintenance of the property.
